Crying out to God in the midst of adversity, we seize the opportunity to realize that our enemies' malevolence is no match for our benevolent God.

A sincere lament directed toward God...

- 1. Guards against denial (Psalm 3:1)
- 2. Breaks the spell of human autonomy & control (v.2 vs. 3-8)
- 3. Affirms the benevolent power of God (v.3)
- 4. Demonstrates trust in God who cares & hears (v.4)
- 5. Sees all of life in proper perspective: in dependent relationship to God (v.5)
- 6. Fuels a right spirit of hope & courage rather than despair (v.6)
- 7. Expects, personalizes & enacts God's saving action (v.7)
- 8. Leads to & manifests a corporate and relational view of life against self-centered, radical individualism (v.8)
