What made them so wise?
A. They were Watchmen: They paid
B. They were Travelers : They paid the of
authentic Faith.
✓ Their wise decision—God speaks: We move.
C. They were Worshippers: They paid
✓ With their <i>Presence</i> more than their <i>Presents</i> !
✓ Seeking God's <i>Presence</i> more than His <i>Presents</i> !
✓ Their wonderful conclusion: Who is Jesus? A great
king worthy of all praise and honor.
II. The Fourth King (Herod)
What made him so foolish?
A. He, too, was a Watchman . He was paying
✓ His on-target question: Where is the Messiah?
✓ His on-target concern: Presence not Presents.
B. He was <i>not</i> a Traveler : Others paid the for
his authentic <i>Fear</i> .
✓ His foolish delusion—I speak: Others move.
C. He was <i>not</i> a Worshipper : He demanded to be the one
paid
✓ His tragic conclusion: Who is Jesus? A rival to be
hated, a threat to be eliminated.
