[LOGOS] (1 Peter 1:22-2:3)

- **oracle** *n*. **1.** An authoritative or wise saying or answer, aprophecy **2.** A person through whom a deity is believed to speak **3.** An answer or decision given by an oracle [< Latin *oraculum* < *orare* to speak]
- LOGOS something said; word; saying; message; teaching; talk; Word (in John); value; thought; reason, grounds; matter, thing
- I. Why is "Word" (LOGOS) such an important word?
 - A. It has significant History...

In its manifold historical application one might almost call it symbolic of the Greek understanding of the world and existence... In Hellenistic mysticism LOGOS is essentially a cosmic and creative potency, the guide and agent of knowledge, increasingly represented as a religious doctrine of salvation, the revealer of what is hidden. - G.
