
Our Mission








Mission Focus

The US Department of State Finally Finds Kelly Kosky (Part 1)

In 2011, US Consulate General Dr. Alberta G.J Mayberry began hearina remarkable anecdotes about an



But this Kosky could not be found in any major African city. Was he a myth? Intentionally elusive?

So finally, Dr. Mayberry traveled with her entourage to the Transkei, a region of South Africa. Word was Kelly and his family had lived among the Xhosa tribe for over three decades. She traveled over 1000 miles with her team to the remote reaion often referred to as the "Wild Coast". In the village of Gatyana, at the main mission station, she was shocked to see the buzzing activity at the Gatyana Bible College and the surrounding agricultural development.

She also visited the numerous schools and clinics established by Kathy and Kelly Kosky. But there was still no trace of Kelly.

After additional inquiries, Dr. Mayberry's group traveled another hour down remote dirt roads to Msbomvu to visit a refuge and development center built for the Xhosa children of the region. As they parked, they were quickly surrounded by a throng of small children anxious to greet them. Security expected trouble but the children were curious, happy, clean and well-fed, unlike the many dirty children in rags they often saw along roads in other parts of the area.
