NOTES:

and I lay down my life for the sheep. (John 10:14-15)

When he has brought all his own sheep out, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they recognize his voice. (John 10:4)



[Christ] laid down his life, not only for the good of the sheep, but in their stead. Thousands of sheep had been offered in sacrifices for their shepherds, as sin-offerings, but here by surprising reverse, the shepherd is sacrificed for the sheep.


