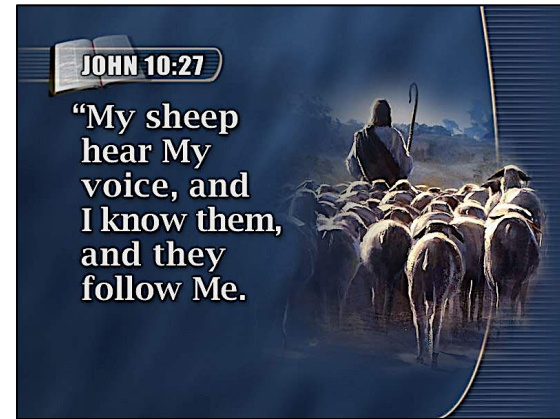
CHRISTMAS TO EASTER #11

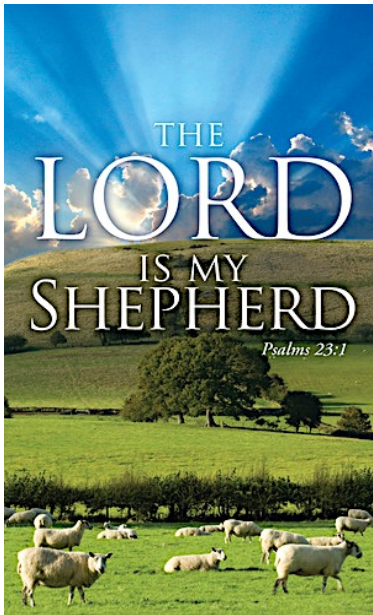
