Father, Again in Jesus' Name We Meet (#380)

- 1 Father, again in Jesus' name we meet, and bow in penitence beneath your feet: again to you our feeble voices raise, to sue for mercy, and to sing your praise.
- 2 O we would bless you for your ceaseless care, and all your works from day to day declare: is not our life with hourly mercies crowned?

 Does not your arm encircle us around?
- 3 Alas, unworthy of your boundless love, too oft with careless feet from you we rove; but now, encouraged by your voice, we come, returning sinners to a Father's home.
- 4 O by that name in whom all fullness dwells, O by that love which ev'ry love excels, O by that blood so freely shed for sin, open blest mercy's gate and take us in.

Jesus, Lover of My Soul (#508)

- 1 Jesus, lover of my soul, let me to thy bosom fly, while the nearer waters roll, while the tempest still is high: hide me, O my Savior, hide, till the storm of life is past; safe into the haven guide, O receive my soul at last!
- 2 Other refuge have I none, hangs my helpless soul on thee; leave, ah! leave me not alone, still support and comfort me! All my trust on thee is stayed, all my help from thee I bring; cover my defenseless head with the shadow of thy wing.

- 3 Thou, O Christ, art all I want; more than all in thee I find: raise the fallen, cheer the faint, heal the sick, and lead the blind. Just and holy is thy name; I am all unrighteousness; false and full of sin I am, thou art full of truth and grace.
- 4 Plenteous grace with thee is found, grace to cover all my sin; let the healing streams abound; make and keep me pure within: thou of life the fountain art, freely let me take of thee; spring thou up within my heart, rise to all eternity.

Amazing Grace (#460)

- 1 Amazing grace!— how sweet the sound—that saved a wretch like me! I once was lost, but now am found, was blind, but now I see.
- 2 'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved; how precious did that grace appear the hour I first believed!
- 3 Thro' many dangers, toils and snares, I have already come; 'tis grace has brought me safe thus far, and grace will lead me home.
- 4 The Lord has promised good to me, his Word my hope secures; he will my shield and portion be, as long as life endures.
- 5 And when this flesh and heart shall fail, and mortal life shall cease, I shall possess within the veil a life of joy and peace.
- 6 When we've been there ten thousand years, bright shining as the sun, we've no less days to sing God's praise than when we've first begun.
