Murrying Down to Disaster #8 2nd Kings 5:15-27

Those who passionately seek to know & serve the Living God
— those working to make themselves godly & grateful —
are wise. Those who seek other things as matters of higher
& prior importance are less so, often tragically less so.

2nd Kings 5 - Three (Dain Characters whom we might call...

1. Godly (Elisha)

• The glory & blessing of Godliness is a life lived according to the presence, power & goodness of God.

2. Greedy (Gehazi)

• The great problem with Greed is not a too-great interest in money and possessions but a too-little interest in God.

3. Grateful (Naaman)

 Gratitude is a sign of human health & wisdom & accompanies godliness offering strong evidence of one's progress in faithful living.
