


Pursuing God's Heart

I have been given an assignment-to be imprisoned for the sake of Jesus. This is a very difficult thing, to be separated from my children, separated from my wife. It has been twenty-two months now. But I bear this assignment, for the sake of Jesus. And I declare-Blessed am I, because for the sake of Jesus many people have wronged me, have persecuted me, and I am now suffering. Blessed am I, because I have been forcibly separated from my wife and children. Blessed am I, because every kind of lie has been told about me, because every kind of slander has been said about me. Blessed am I, because I am in prison. I am kept in prison by force, I do not want to be there. But I choose willingly to suffer for the sake of Jesus, and by suffering for his sake I hope to display for everyone his incomparable worth.
