Principles from Israel's demise (that people tend not to believe)...

I. "Under God" is a fact and not merely an aspiration.

II. When a nation presumes to substitute "Under God" with "Over God" it is on its way from "one nation" to "no nation."


III. Under God, Annihilation is never the real threat:

IV. Israel's relationship with God was unique: Its moral failures and resulting political extinction are universal.

V. The fact of "Under God" means we are never beyond hope.
