Nurrying Down to Disaster #19 2nd Kings 18:1-12

Those chosen by God and faithful to Him will sometimes have to be rebels against established, feared & acclaimed forces of evil & error and to be ready to pay the price for such rebellion.

Nezekiah, trusted Yahweh God & accepted no substitutes...

A. The rebelled actively against false worship.

"The removed the high places and broke the pillars and cut down the Asherah. And he broke in pieces the bronze serpent..."(v.4)

B. The rebelled against the pressures of precedence ${\mathcal C}$ legacy.

"...there was none like him among all the kings of Judah after him, nor among those who were before him." (v.5)


C. The trusted Yahweh God with uncommon courage & faith.

"...be held fast to the LORD. The did not depart from following him, but kept the commandments that the LORD commanded (Doses..." (v.4)

D. The took rebellious action against worldly powers that existed in rebellion against Yahweh God.

"... The rebelled against the king of Assyria and would not serve him. The struck down the Philistines..." (v.7-8)
