
[God-centeredness produces righteousness.]

When our reserves of righteousness run out, when our weak flesh conquers our willing spirits, our God's unassailable power, absolute holiness, unchanging grace, transcendent goodness & sovereign love shine bright.

Additional Notes:

God still acts, not out of reaction to circumstance, but out of freedom. Hezekiah parades his piety before God (v.3), but Yahweh responds for his own sake and for the sake of his servant David (v.6). Even when faced with unbelief, Yahweh heals and extends the reign of the king by some fifteen years (v.6a). If in any way the king stands as a symbol for the nation, then the lesson of history had not been learned.


