2nd Peter: A Faith Worth Defending #5 (2nd Peter 2:1-10a)



It is important for us to have good judgment...
We must affirm the reality of coming divine judgment.
To do otherwise leads us into temptation and denies and dishonors the Lord Jesus who is our Savior.

Notes:

While it is evident that 2 Peter originates as a farewell speech motivated by the author's sense of impending death, his major concern as he writes is to warn his readers about destructive heresies that will enter the church after his demise... Apparently these destructive heresies had to do with teaching that denied the return of Christ in judgment and consequently encouraged a licentious lifestyle that followed "the corrupt desire of the flesh" (2:10).
