A sincere mind is a great gift of God and involves remembering the right things and knowing what matters.


Peter's Stated Goal for his 2 letters:

- To stir up your sincere minds (ESV)
- To stimulate you to wholesome thinking (NIV)

This sincere mind / wholesome thinking means remembering/recalling & knowing/understanding.

- A. *Remember* (Look backward & think well...)
 - 1. The predictions of the holy prophets
 - 2. The commandment of our Lord & Savior
- B. **Know** (Look forward & think well...)
 - 1. Scoffers will come ("How to wreck the Faith step 4")
 - 2. Jesus is trustworthy & will return a. God's righteous judgment has come before
 - b. God's righteous judgment must come again
 - 3. God is great & good

This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder... - 2nd Peter 3:1


